Wyoming Land Trust Celebrates First Year with Community-Wide Picnic

The Wyoming Land Trust Picnic will take place August 13 at 5:00 pm at Seven Mile River Ranch west of Pinedale off Highway 191. The event is free and open to the public. Food, fun and entertainment for Wyoming people of all ages will be provided.

Trapper's Point – Migration route vantage point where an overview of the Corridor Conservation Campaign will be given.

Conservation and Energy Partnerships – Observe conservation along with oil and gas operations in action on Paradise Road in Boulder, Wyoming.
