Wyoming Land Trust and Teton Science Schools Engage Youth in Conservation

Sweetwater County Students Invited to Attend WY Nature Camp, July 11–15
Rock Springs, Wyoming – Wyoming Nature Camp, which quickly sold out in Casper and Pinedale, is coming to Sweetwater County July 11–15. Space still remains for local youth to spend one week identifying native plants and animals, studying the ecology of local wetlands, learning about the history of wild horses in Wyoming, touring a mine, and exploring the landscape of the Rock Springs area.

"Wyoming Nature Camps provide an excellent opportunity to engage the next generation of Wyomingites in agriculture, wildlife, conservation, energy and other natural resources in the state," said Wyoming Land Trust Executive Director Lara Ryan. "We've got an exciting camp planned in Sweetwater County this summer and are encouraging kids from grades 1 to 6 to enroll. Space is limited, so be sure to sign up today!"

The Wyoming Land Trust and Teton Science Schools have teamed up this summer to host four camps across the state which will give Wyoming children the opportunity to learn about natural resources. Approximately 150 youth from across the state are expected to participate. Wyoming Nature Camps are open to all Wyoming children grades 1 through 6. The camp runs from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily.
